ABOUT NUMEROLOGY

WHAT IS NUMEROLOGY?

Numerology is the study of the symbolism of numbers. It is used to determine a person or an animal's personality, strengths, talents, and obstacles to be overcome, including inner needs, emotional reactions, and ways of dealing with others.

The roots of numerology can be traced back 10,000 years to Egypt and Babylonia. Pythagoras, who developed many of the basic theorems that form the foundation of modern mathematics, is credited with formally organizing the field of numerology about 2600 years ago in ancient Greece.

HOW NUMEROLOGY WORKS?

Everything in the universe vibrates at its own particular frequency. By finding the vibration rate of any object, you can establish the qualities and energies associated with it. You can determine the major frequencies of different people by applying the principles of numerology, and using only the name and birth date as basic data.

This numerological analysis provides significant insight into people's personalities and their characters.

For pets, their natural temperament will count for 70% and the names chosen will count for 30%.

Story

A couple bought a Doberman puppy hoping that when he grew up he would guard the house, be alert to any strange, noise or behavior, and be aggressive as well.

When he was little, the Doberman was mellow and played excessively. His owner still thought that he would be a beast once he grew up. The owner named the dog “Hoover”, which is number THREE in numerology.

Well, Hoover kept playing even after he became an adult, and nothing would stop Hoover from playing. The owner kept saying to himself; “At least, his size will scare people away”.

After some time, the same family received a little Fox Terrier as a gift. They named the dog Igor, which is number FOUR in numerology.

Igor was really smart, but he had an unpredictable temper and liked to bite everybody. Whenever the family arrived home, Hoover, the Doberman, would greet them, while Igor, the little dog, would bite Hoover. It was funny watching the big Doberman being bitten by that little Fox Terrier.

To prevent this type of situation, you should know how to choose the correct name for your pet. The numerology of a name forms the character of a person, a pet, a product or even a business.



NUMEROLOGY

How to Analyze a Name

The NAME of your pet has to be analyzed in three different ways:

- 1. Personality = It is the sum of all letters in the name.** See **Personality** chapter.
- 2. Instinctive Reactions = It is the first vowel of their names.** See **Reactions** chapter.
- 3. Inner Behavior = It is the sum of all vowels.** See **Behavior** chapter.



Numerology for All Animals

Numerology affects humans both visually and acoustically.

It works as follows:

- We visualize the name
- We speak the name
- We hear the name

In this process, we build up a sound that provokes a positive or negative reaction. Just like humans, animals create a psychological profile through hearing their names. It is like a note of a melody or a musical scale made through the letters that form the words. Each word has a sound, and each animal has a different hearing frequency.

The Basic Numerology Calculation

In the basic calculation in numerology, the numbers are reduced by simple addition.

In numerology for animals, all numbers are reduced to single digits 1 through 9. The numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9 represent the major vibration rates associated with people and animals' characteristics.

The number 15, for instance, is reduced by adding $1 + 5$ to get 6. Correspondingly, the number 1974 can be reduced by adding $1 + 9 + 7 + 4$ to get 21. The 21 can be further reduced by adding $2 + 1$ to get 3.

The letters in a name are converted to numbers and then added together. These numbers, in turn, are also reduced.

The letter A, for instance, is 1; the letter B is 2; the letter C is 3, and so forth.

The following table shows the numbers assigned to all 26 letters in the English alphabet.

Learn To Add the Letters

Example 1: TATOO

1. Write down the name to be analyzed following the table above.

$T = 2, A = 1, T = 2, O = 6, O = 6$

2. Add the numbers and simplify them into ONE number.

TATOO = $2+1+2+6+6=17$. The number 17 is equal $1+7=8$. Therefore, EIGHT is the number to be analyzed.

Example 2: SMOKY

1. Get the equivalent number for each letter from the table above: S = 1, M = 4, O = 6, K = 2, Y = 7

2. Add the numbers and simplify them into ONE number:

$1 + 4 + 6 + 2 + 7 = 20$. The number 11 is equal $2+0 = 2$.

Therefore, TWO is the number to be analyzed.

Nick Names

Once you choose a name for your pet, avoid giving him a nick name. For instance, a dog can sense sounds at four times the distance of a human. If you understand how your dog hears, you'll be able to communicate better with him because you'll see how he perceives the world.

Compared to humans, who can hear frequencies between 20 Hz and 20,000 Hz, dogs can hear sounds between 67 Hz and 45,000 to 60,000 Hz, depending on the breed.

Animals depend on their acute sense of hearing to survive, to hunt, to protect, to detect and to perform.

Story

John's kids were always asking him for a dog, but John always said no to his kids.

One day, John got home and saw his kids playing with this cute puppy. It was a gift from John's parents to his kids. John decided to keep the puppy and make his kids happy.

Well, it came the time to choose a name for the dog. The family got together and started brain storming on different names. Finally, they chose “Jefferson” as the name for the puppy, which is number EIGHT in numerology.

For few days, the kids, John and his wife called the puppy Jefferson, but then John started calling the puppy “Jeff”(number NINE), and his kids called the puppy “J” (number ONE).

Time passed and the dog started to get a little confused and sometimes ignoring the family when called. Jeff, the puppy, preferred spending his time playing with his own toys.

The family, not knowing what was going on with the dog, decided to take the dog to the veterinarian and have his ears checked. The veterinarian found nothing wrong with it.

When the dog went back to the waiting room, the veterinarian heard the dog being called by many different names: “Is Jeff OK? Jefferson, come here baby! J, let’s play!”

The veterinarian immediately realized that the dog was confused hearing so many names. He kindly advised the family to call the dog by one name only.

The family went back home and chose “Jeff” as the official name for the dog.

A few days later, Jeff, the dog, was answering everybody’s call and playing with the kids.

So, when choosing a name for your pet, stick with it, and avoid calling your pet by a different name.
